

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Gandhi Shikshan Bhavan's Smt. A group of teachers, namely Acharya Bhise, Dr. Airon, Shri.Haribhai Trivedi, Miss Sulabha Majumdar, Shri.L.N.Chhapekar, Shri.G.L.Chandavarkar, Panandikar. Shri H.B Shri.K.S.Acharlu, Shri Shesh Namele, Shri Indra Vasavda and Shri Vajubhai Patel Smt.Leelaben Patel were interested in the theory and practice of Basic Education, formed an association in 1964 called Indian Council of Basic Education and got it registered under the Bombay Public Trust Act of 1950. Council membership is open only to believers of the concept of Basic Education and those who are teachers.
